I am trying to fight the traffic ticket I received for the accident and the prosecutor has asked me to get a **restitution letter** from my insurance company. The prosecutors in Louisiana usually ask for a restitution letter to confirm the accident is being reviewed by my insurance company as a civil matter. The prosecutors are usually looking for a letter from you which provides one of the following explanations about the insurance company's investigation into the accident.

1. Both drivers reported the accident, and my insurance company has accepted liability for the damages.
2. Both drivers reported the accident, but my insurance has denied liability for the damages. The prosecutor is does not need a reason for why you chose to deny liability.
3. The other driver has not made a claim, so my insurance company doesn't have anyone to pay damages to regardless of my insurance's company's determination of liability.
